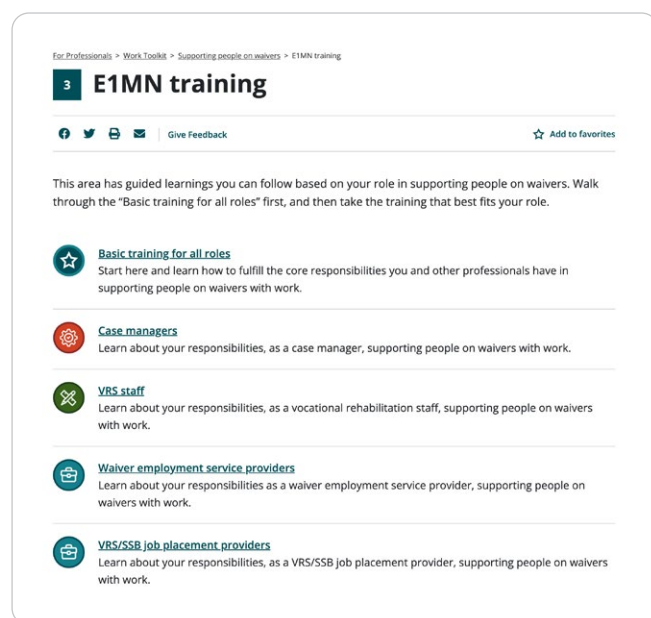
Take the [E1MN Training](#): Free, self-paced online training to help you understand your role in supporting people on their employment journey.
